Within the Signature Value Formulary, medications are grouped by therapeutic class and then Formulary or Non-Formulary.

Medications moving to a higher coverage level

We evaluate medications based on their total value, including how a medication works and how much it costs. When several medications work in the same way, we may choose to move the higher-cost option to a higher coverage level.
