Introducing virtual dental visits—also called teledentistry—an easier way to see a dentist without going to the dentist’s office. These virtual dental visits connect you with a licensed dentist by computer or mobile device—so you can get the care you need whenever, wherever.*

After you register online with DialCare—a network teledentistry provider—you’ll be able to:

- **Use teledentistry for \$0 out-of-pocket**—Your dental plan benefits include 2 virtual dental visits per plan year.** These virtual visits are in addition to the routine in-person exams that are included in your plan.
- **Connect virtually by phone or video**—Get a second opinion, treatment options or a medically necessary prescription from state-licensed and fully credentialed dentists. If your own dentist offers secure virtual dental services, you can use your teledentistry benefit with them.
- **Get 24/7 help for a variety of nonemergency dental conditions**—Dentists can consult on conditions including oral pain, broken or sensitive teeth, gum swelling and bleeding, orthodontia needs and more.
