

# HMO, EOA AND POS<sup>1</sup> PREVENTIVE CARE SUMMARY

Health Net's preventive health guidelines allow Health Net members and their doctors to determine individual needs for preventive care services based on the best available medical evidence.

Preventive care services include health education, counseling and clinical services, such as, well-baby/child care, immunizations, vision screening and hearing screening for children, clinical laboratory and radiology.

The majority of these guidelines are based and consistent with the United States Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF), Recommendations for Preventive Pediatric Health Care, as adopted by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and the Recommended Childhood Immunization Schedule/United States jointly adopted by the American Academy of Pediatrics, the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) of the U.S. Public Health Service and the American Academy of Family Physicians.
